Application Requirements for Speech Competition

Application Requirements for All Fine Arts Scholarships

1. Fill out the Incoming Freshman Fine Arts Scholarship Application Form and **mail** it to GC's Admissions office by **December 7, 2018**.
2. **Attach a letter of recommendation from the applicant's current theatre, band, orchestra, vocal instructor, piano instructor or an adult other than the parent who is familiar with the student's experience (not required for visual arts).**
3. Confirm interview or audition date and time (see procedure below).

Theatre scholarship applicants

Performance: Theatre applicants interested in performance will be sent materials regarding auditions electronically. Candidates are required to come to the audition on **January 26, 2019** from **9:00-12:00pm** with an age appropriate monologue not exceeding one minute in length. Applicants will be led through a series of group exercises consisting of improvisation, ensemble collaboration and open scenes. The audition will take approximately three hours, during which a parent information session will be held. Information regarding audition scheduling will be sent out via email. Please make sure the email address you indicated on your information sheet is legible and active.

Production/Design: Theatre applicants interested in production and design will need to compile a resume of relevant experience, a letter of recommendation, and any other materials (pictures, video, etc.) that can demonstrate their experience in theatre production or design. Students will attend an interview with the theatre faculty on either **January 22**. Information regarding scheduling will be sent out via email. Please make sure the email address you indicated on your information sheet is legible and active.

Music applicants

Students applying for instrumental scholarships will download instructions and audition materials from the music website: goodcounselmusic.org on or after **December 15, 2018**. Click on the "scholarship auditions" tab. Follow the directions to download the appropriate audition materials and to sign-up for an audition date and time-slot.

Students applying for choir and piano scholarships need to perform a prepared piece of their choosing. Visit goodcounselmusic.org to sign up for an audition date and time-slot after **December 15, 2018**.

Art applicants

Applicants must provide in advance of the interview, a digital portfolio (digital photos on a disk, USB, or link to photo sharing site) of original artwork (10-12 pieces). At the interview applicants will present their physical portfolio and be invited to discuss their particular interests in art. They will also be asked to demonstrate basic drawing skills. Interview date and time options will be e-mailed after the application is received.
